Job Description

Job Title: Shape Molder/Parts Packager

Department: Shape Mold **Reports to:** Shape Mold Supervisor

Summary: Helps prepare material for molding. Operates press(s) to produce molded parts. Prepares for and packages parts. Consistently acts as a representative of Benchmark Foam by personifying the company's Core Values of Integrity, Commitment, and Excellence.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential duties. Benchmark Foam operates on the principle of effective teamwork. Other duties may be assigned, including cross-training and/or working in other departments.

Checks raw material levels. Starts the press. Ensures that steam, water and air levels are appropriate by checking gauges. Preheats the press. Engages the press to produce test part. Inspects test part for quality.

If needed, troubleshoots by tuning in the press by adjusting steam, water and air. Runs test cycles to ensure quality parts. Adjusts cycle times to achieve optimum part output.

Removes parts from conveyor. Inspects parts for quality. If part is substandard, performs count, then disposes of by using established procedures. If part is of acceptable quality, places in cart. Places cart in appropriate dryer according to required drying time. Monitors part drying time, testing parts for adequate dryness. Once parts are adequately dry, removes carts from dryer.

Constructs part containers. Inspecting individual parts for quality, packs parts in containers, using knowledge of space & volume. Following established procedures, seals, then labels containers. Place containers on pallet, then stretch wraps. According to size and shape, places containers in appropriate shipping area.

Performs troubleshooting and tuning in of press throughout production process as required to achieve efficient, maximum output. Identifies need for machinery repair and summons appropriate personnel. Performs minor repairs if trained to do so. Reports all repair needs to appropriate personnel. Performs record-keeping by performing data entry for substandard part counts, quality part counts, quantity of raw material used, time utilized to produce parts

Consistently cleans work area. Follows all safety policies/procedures. Trains on the operation of multiple machines.

Supervisory Responsibilities
